

2024 Arkansas Engenia® Herbicide Checklist

For Applications Made From April 16 through June 30



Nozzle:

Approved tank-mixes:

See www.engeniatankmix.com
DO NOT tank-mix with glyphosate



Sensitive crops and residential areas:

DO NOT apply within 1 mile in any direction of University and USDA research stations
DO NOT apply within 1/2 mile in any direction of certified organic crops and commercially grown specialty crops
DO NOT apply within 1/4 mile in any direction of non-dicamba tolerant crops
DO NOT spray if wind is blowing toward neighboring sensitive crops or residential areas



Sensitive areas:

Leave 240' downwind buffer to sensitive areas (non-residential, uncultivated areas or bodies of water)

Sensitive areas in endangered species counties:

Leave 310' downwind buffer in counties with endangered species with 57' buffer on all other sides of the field
Consult www.epa.gov/espp or call 1-844-447-3813 and follow any county specific dicamba use restrictions for corresponding endangered species



Wind speed:

Only spray when wind is between 3–10 MPH



Avoid inversions: DO NOT apply when temperature inversions exist at the field level

Daytime spraying: Only apply one hour after sunrise until two hours before sunset



Ground speed:

≤ 15 mph



Boom height:

≤ 24 inches above target



Record keeping:

Create records within 72 hours

Application parameters
Tank cleanout
Planting date
Buffer zone determination
Type of equipment used
Commercial application equipment number
Keep records for 3 years



Spray volume:

≥ 15 GPA



Additional AR restrictions:

Proof of dicamba training prior to purchase
Only dicamba products approved for OTT use may be used in burndown
